The AFM-Diplom



You've already worked it - haven't you???

But it is really not difficult:

Licensed radio amateurs and SWLs need:

DL-Station	15 Points
EU-Station	10 Points
DX-Station	5 Points

Any QSO with a member of the Förderverein Amateurfunkmuseum counts one point per band. QSOs with club stations of Förderverein Amateurfunkmuseum or the collaborating amateur radio museums are counting five points (only once!). QSOs with those local groups of the DARC who are member of the Förderverein Amateurfunkmuseum are counting three points (only once!).

For equipment that has been donated to the Förderverein Amateurfunkmuseum a score of between one and five points can be granted.

The number of points granted will be determined by a jury.

All QSOs having taken place after November 21st, 1981 (which is the foundation day of Förderverein Amateurfunkmuseum) are valid for this diploma.

This diploma has been acknowledged by the club of DARC in October 1985.
